

Improvement of Service Delivery - Municipal Infrastructure

Service delivery in South Africa remains a big challenge for municipalities. By lacking in infrastructure, resources and maintenance, they are unable to provide communities with quality service delivery in a quickest turnaround time.

Joe Morolong Local Municipality is pleased to report and highlight some of the successful and impactful Municipal Infrastructure projects which were completed and handed over to the community throughout the 2022/23 Financial Year, mainly focusing on Water Supply Project, Roads and Sanitation Projects.

We should also acknowledge that there are challenges. Community protests due to plough back issues and in some projects, this affected completion. Internal processes of Entities like ESKOM are contributors in the delays on projects completion which the Municipality cannot account or take full responsibility.

HIGHLIGHTS OF SOME COMPLETED PROJECTS

- Phase 1 of Water Supply Projects 8
- Seven (7) Boreholes are refurbished although Three (3) are practically completed.
- 3.2 Kilometers Road is paved and another one is practically completed.
- 290 budgeted Sanitation projects are practically completed and only one which was stopped by the community.
