Joe Morolong Local Municipality together with United Manganese of Kalahari mine(UMK) handed over the rural water supply project estimated at the cost of about R34 265 592.91

The project scope amongst others includes the refurbishment of the two electrical boreholes, water reticulation and storage facilities.

The Mayor emphasized the importance of water & its scarcity. She reiterated that the water scheme or supply should be shared equally between neighbouring villages.

Accompanied by the Members of the Executive Committee, Infrastructure Chairperson Cllr. G. Kaotsane, Chairperson of Planning, Development and Tourism Cllr. N. Mokweni, Ward 10 Cllr Thapelo Mosegedi, the Representatives of United Manganese of Kalahari Mine (UMK) Ms. Gloria Mbatha and Mr.

Terrence Mamabolo, the Mayor of Joe Morolong Local Municipality Cllr Dineo Leutlwetse-Tshabalala handed over gigantic rural water supply project that aims to improve the lives of the communities of Lebonkeng and Gamadubu.

Today, the main contractor Tsaathebe Construction was formally introduced to the community. He was accompanied by the engineers of the project that presented the detailed scope and overview of the project to community.
