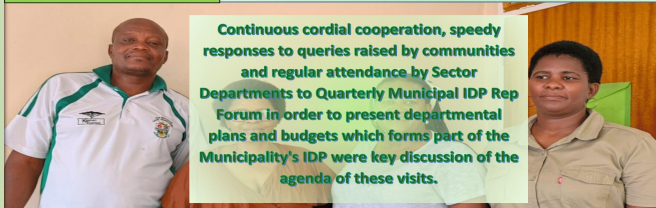

INFRASTRUCTURE

“To ensure that service delivery is rendered to our people and there is an improved. The municipality handed over a rural water supply project estimated at about R34 265 592. 91 to the community of Lebonkeng and Gamadubu”.
